What are Medi-Cal Long Term Services and Supports?	
<ul> <li>In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) are personal care services for people who need help to live safely in their homes. If you currently get IHSS, you do not have to change your IHSS providers and you can still hire, fire, and manage your providers.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS) is daytime health care at centers that provide nursing, therapy, activities and meals for people with certain chronic health conditions.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP) provides social and health care MU_9003910_ENG1114</li> </ul>	

coordination services for people age 65 and older. If you<u>already</u> get MSSP, your health plan will work with your MSSP providers to better coordinate your care.

If you currently get MSSP, yYou do not have to change your MSSP provider.

- Nursing home care: If you get care in a nursing home, your health plan will work with your doctor and nursing home to better coordinate your care. If you are currently in a nursing home, you do not have to change your nursing home. <u>If you are interested in living in a different nursing home or outside of</u> a nursing home with home and community-based supports and services, your health plan will discuss these options with you.
- If you do not get these <u>long-term</u> services <u>and supports</u> now, your health plan can help you get them in the future, if you need them.

Can I see my <u>Medicare</u> doctors after I enroll in a Medi-Cal health plan? Yes, if you have Medicare, your Medicare providers will not change.

Can I see my <u>Medi-Cal</u> doctors after I enroll in a Medi-Cal health plan? If you have Medi-Cal only, you will need to check with your health plan to determine if your providers work with the health plan. Generally, you are able to see your current doctors for 12 months.

Enrolling in a Medi-Cal health plan:

- Does NOT change your Medicare services or benefits.
- Does NOT change your Medi-Cal eligibility or cost you extra.
- Does NOT cut any of your Medi-Cal services or benefits, but you may have to change some providers, like where you get your medical equipment.

When do I need to enroll in a Medi-Cal health plan?

If you do not make a choice, you will be enrolled in a Medi-Cal health plan starting MM/DD/YYYY.
